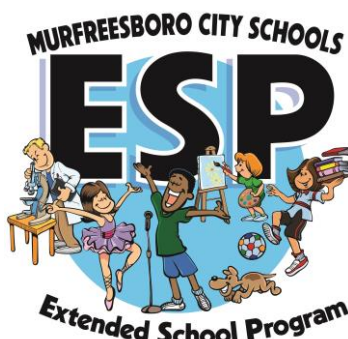
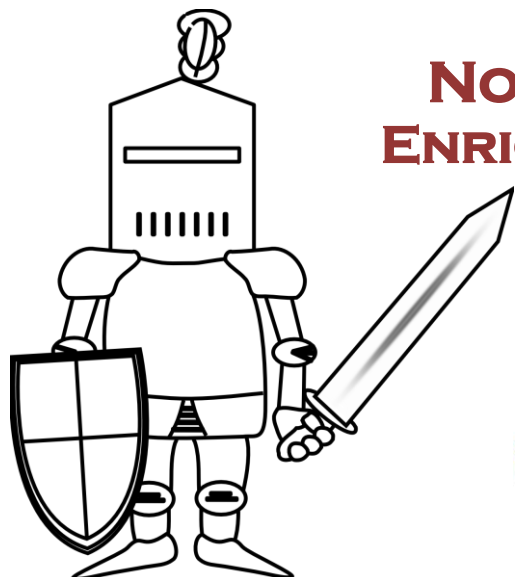


NORTHFIELD ESP ENRICHMENT CLASSES
